American Statesman, Former Secretary of Education, Political Theorist, and Author

Dr. Bennett is one of America's most important, influential, and respected voices on cultural, political, and education issues. A native of Brooklyn, New York, Bill Bennett studied philosophy at Williams College (B.A.) and the University of Texas (Ph.D.) and earned a law degree (J.D.) from Harvard. Bennett's best-known written work may be *The Book of Virtues: A Treasury of Great Moral Stories* (1993). He has also authored and edited eleven other books, including *The Book of Man: Readings on the Path to Manhood* (2011).

Dr. Bennett is a three-time confirmed executive in the Ronald Reagan and George H.W. Bush administrations including holding two cabinet-level positions. He is a long-time supporter of Scouting and a firm believer in the life-long benefits that Scouting delivers to youth across the nation.
